VINEYARD Located in the heart of the Uco Valley
La Consulta, San Carlos, Mendoza

AREA 10 hectares

VARIETAL 100% Malbec

ALTITUDE 1050 Meters above sea level (3400 ft)

SOIL Poor soil, a mix of sand loam and rocky bottom

IRRIGATION Flood irrigation. Rainfall 250mm yearly

PLANTING DENSITY 5500 plants per hectare

TRAINING SYSTEM Double guyot

YIELD 1 Plant = 1 Bottle

HARVEST Hand picking

VINIFICATION Micro-winemaking method in 225
liters French Oak barrels. 15 Days cold maceration.
Barrel rotation and hand pigeage

AGING 24 months in barrel. 12 months in bottle

ANALYSIS 15% alcohol. PH 3.7. Sugar 2 gr

PRODUCTION 1000 cases
